To the Territorial Highway Engineer:

WHEREAS, no road now connects

THEREFORE, we direct that you expend such sums as are necessary to construct a suitable road connecting the airstrip with the town of South Naknek.

HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. 6

To Clarence J. Rhode, Regional Director, United States Fish and Wildlife Service:

Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska in Twenty-second Regular Session assembled, respectfully submits that;

WHEREAS, you have seen fit to order certain fishwheels removed and the sites vacated along the Yukon River, especially in the vicinity of Ruby and Kokrines, and

WHEREAS, such removal has deprived the natives in those areas

from their customary food supply and has produced hunger and want and interfered with their ancestral way of life,

NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska in Twenty-second Regular Session assembled, requests that during the 1955 salmon season these natives along the Yukon River be allowed to reinstall their fishwheels for the purpose of non-commercial fishing.

And your Memorialist will ever pray.
