HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 11

Be it Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska:

WHEREAS, matters concerning

the regulation and operation of the Employment Security Commission involve large numbers of the residents of the Territory of Alaska, and

WHEREAS, Federal conformity is required in connection with any changes in existing laws, in order to assure the proper contributions to provide an insurance coverage to be afforded, and

WHEREAS, the present fund is in a serious state of depletion, thereby requiring immediate action on this matter;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RE-

SOLVED by the House of Representatives, that Mr. A. A. Hedges, as Acting Executive Director of the Alaska Employment Security Commission, is hereby directed to request the presence of Regional Director Daniel Goldy, before the House of Representatives and its committee to furnish expert testimony on matters of Employment Security currently before this body. Such presence to be at the mutual convenience of Mr. Goldy and the House of Representatives.

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 12

Be it Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska:

WHEREAS, the village of Kokrines, Alaska, has 23 children of school age, and

WHEREAS, there has been no school in said village since 1946 and no education is provided said children with the result that the morale and conditions in said village has been greatly lowered, and

WHEREAS, an investigation should be made and funds provided to establish an elementary school at Kokrines,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that Department of Education is hereby directed to investigate the educational problems at Kokrines, Alaska, with the purpose of establishing elementary school facilities therein if the budget of said Department will permit during the coming biennium.
