

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 5

Be it Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska:

WHEREAS, eighteen miles of road was built from mile 159 on the Glenn Highway to Lake Louise at public expense by the United States Army; and

WHEREAS, Lake Louise is a highly desirable recreational area

and tourist attraction; and

WHEREAS, the maintenance of said road is in the best interests of the Territory of Alaska;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that the Highway Engineer be and he is hereby directed to provide for the maintenance of the Lake Louise Highway.

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 6

Be it Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska:

WHEREAS, The Alaska Property Tax Act was passed in 1949; and

WHEREAS, thereafter an action was filed seeking to declare said act void; and

WHEREAS, the matter was heard before the Circuit Court of Appeals for the 9th circuit on at least two occasions whereat the Territory of Alaska was represented by the Attorney General of Alaska in defense of said act at a cost to the taxpayers of Alaska amounting to thousands of dollars; and

WHEREAS, on the 25th day of May, 1954, the court held said act valid; and

WHEREAS, substantial sums are now owed the Territory under said act by those that sought to declare the act void; and

WHEREAS, frequent demands have been made on the Territorial Tax Commissioner, Karl Dewey, by the Attorney General to deliver records and information upon which suits could be brought against these delinquent accounts; and

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of February, 1955, the Attorney Gen-
