CHAPTER 11

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$10,000.00 as a deficiency appropriation to be used in paying United States Commissioners, Clerks of Court, and others for recording and reporting Vital Statistics records; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 91)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$10,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the use of the Registrar of Vital Statistics in paying United States Commissioners, Clerks of Court, and others for recording and re-

porting Vital Statistics records for the biennium ending March 31, 1957.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 12

AN ACT

To appropriate \$15,000.00 as a deficiency appropriation to be used in paying School Boards and Physicians for physical examinations conducted during the biennium ending June 30, 1957; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 92)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$15,000.00 or

so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated to reimburse school boards and physi-

cians for physical examinations of school children as authorized by Section 37-7-11 ACLA 1949 as amended by Chapter 118 SLA 1949 and further amended by Chapter 72 SLA 1953, for the biennium ending June 30, 1957.

Section 2. Expenditures under

this Act shall be authorized by vouchers approved by the Commissioner of Health.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 13

AN ACT

Relating to adverse possession against the Territory; amending Sec. 58-7-6, ACLA 1949.

(S. B. 8)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Sec. 58-7-6, ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 58-7-6. When possession conclusively presumed to give

title. The uninterrupted adverse notorious possession of real property under color and claim of title for seven years or more shall be conclusively presumed to give title thereto except as against the United States or the Territory of Alaska.

CHAPTER 14

AN ACT

Relating to correspondence courses for prospectors and miners by the University of Alaska.

(S. B. 28)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The University of Alaska shall set up and offer to bona fide Alaskan prospectors and

miners within Alaska a correspondence course, or courses, equal and parallel to the Mining Extension Course presently being taught.
