## CHAPTER 13

### AN ACT

**Relating to adverse possession against the Territory; amending Sec. 58-7-6, ACLA 1949.**

(S. B. 8)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. Sec. 58-7-6, ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 58-7-6. When possession conclusively presumed to give**

title. The uninterrupted adverse notorious possession of real property under color and claim of title for seven years or more shall be conclusively presumed to give title thereto except as against the United States or the Territory of Alaska.

## CHAPTER 14

### AN ACT

**Relating to correspondence courses for prospectors and miners by the University of Alaska.**

(S. B. 28)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. The University of Alaska shall set up and offer to bona fide Alaskan prospectors and

miners within Alaska a correspondence course, or courses, equal and parallel to the Mining Extension Course presently being taught.

Sec. 2. The University of Alaska

is empowered to make the minimum of material, books and postage charge necessary to defray costs used in such course.

## CHAPTER 15

### AN ACT

**Relating to per diem of members of the Legislature; repealing Section 4-6-4, ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 4, ESLA 1949.**

(H. B. 57)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. Section 4-6-4, ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 4, ESLA 1949, is hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 16

### AN ACT

**Amending Section 37-2-8, as amended by adding subsection (13) thereto, to provide specific authority for the Territorial Board of Education to acquire and transfer property.**

(H. B. 72)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. Sec. 37-2-8, ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 72, SLA 1951, and Chapter 62, SLA 1955, is hereby amended by adding there-to subsection (13) as follows:

(13) (a) Acquire and transfer

personal property.

(b) Acquire real property.

(c) Transfer real property to Federal agencies, Territorial agencies or to any Territorial political subdivisions.
