## CHAPTER 178

### AN ACT

**Appropriating \$2,000.00 to the Alaska Safety Council for the use of the Executive Board in paying the salary of a Safety Director and such other employees as are deemed necessary, and for the organizational expenses, for the period April 1, 1957 through June 30, 1957; and declaring an emergency.**

(S. B. 131)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Executive Board of the Alaska Safety Council, for the period April 1, 1957 through June 30, 1957, out of any monies in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$2,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purpose of paying

the salary of a Safety Director and such other employees as are required, and for other expenses necessary to the implementation of those functions and duties assigned the Council in Ch. 109, SLA 1955, as amended by the Twenty-third Legislature.

Sec. 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect April 1, 1957.

## CHAPTER 179

### AN ACT

**Pertaining to salaries, qualifications, and numbers of teachers, principals, vice-principals, head teachers, teachers-in-charge, and superintendents in schools in the Territory of Alaska; repealing and re-enacting Sections 37-6-1 and 37-6-2, ACLA 1949, as last amended by Chapter 176, Session Laws of Alaska 1955; repealing and re-enacting Section 37-6-3, ACLA 1949; amending Sections 37-6-4, 37-6-5, and 37-6-6, ACLA 1949; and establishing an effective date.**

(C. S. for C. S. for H. B. 62)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. Section 37-6-1, ACLA 1949, as last amended by Chapter 176, Session Laws of Alaska 1955, is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

**Section 37-6-1. Teachers' Salary Scale by Divisions.** The school boards of school districts in the Territory of Alaska and the Ter-

ritorial Board of Education as the operating school board for schools outside school districts shall pay regularly qualified teachers employed by them and with public school experience in Alaska allowable in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Territorial Board of Education a salary which shall be not less than that set forth in the following scale:

Section 2. Section 37-6-2, ACLA 1949, as last amended by Chapter 176, Session Laws of Alaska 1955, is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

**Section 37-6-2. Superintendent's Salary Scale by Divisions.** The school boards of school districts in the Territory of Alaska and the Territorial Board of Education as the operating school board for schools outside school districts shall pay regularly qualified superintendents employed by them and with public school administrative experience in Alaska allowable in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Territorial Board of Education a salary which shall be not less than that set forth in the following scale:

Section 3. Section 37-6-3, ACLA 1949, is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

**Section 37-6-3. Amounts Established Above Salary Scale for Principals, Vice-Principals, Head Teachers, and Teachers-in-Charge.** The school boards of school districts in the Territory of Alaska and the Territorial Board of Education as the operating school board for schools outside school districts shall pay regularly qualified principals, vice-principals, head teachers, and teachers-in-charge employed by them a salary which shall be not

less than the allowable salary on the Teachers' Salary Scale for the Judicial Division in which employed plus the following amounts in all Judicial Divisions:

Principals

—\$600 above Teachers' Scale

Vice-Principals

—\$300 above Teachers' Scale

Head Teachers

\$300 above Teachers' Scale

Teachers-in-Charge

\$150 above Teachers' Scale

Section 4. Section 37-6-4, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 37-6-4. Reimbursement to School Districts: Position on Salary Schedule as Determining: Employment at a Rate Higher than the Salary Scale.** Reimbursement from the Territory to school districts shall be made at the percentum rate prescribed by law, and be made in the same manner; provided, however, that the reimbursement allowed on each employed teacher's, superin-

tendent's, principal's, vice-principal's, head teacher's, or teacher's-in-charge salary shall be determined by the salary scale position of the employed as established by the Territorial Board of Education; and provided further, that no reimbursement shall be made to any school district in Alaska on any salary paid which is less than the scale or any amount which is in excess of the scale established by law. Nothing in this Act shall be construed as prohibiting the employment of a teacher, superintendent, principal, vice-principal, head teacher, or teacher-in-charge at a higher rate than the scale specified in this Act, either by a school district board or the Territorial Board of Education as the operating board for schools outside school districts.

Section 5. Section 37-6-5, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 37-6-5. Statement of Qualifications: Filing: Contents.** A statement of the qualifications of each teacher and superintendent employed by the Territorial Board of Education or by a school district shall be filed with the

Commissioner of Education; such statement shall set forth the credits earned in college, normal school or university, and the number of years of teaching experience both in Alaska and elsewhere in such form and manner as may be prescribed by the Commissioner of Education.

Section 6. Section 37-6-6, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 37-6-6. Determination of Number of Teachers, Superintendents, Principals, Vice-Principals, and Head Teachers for Which District Entitled to Reimbursement.** The maximum number of teachers, superintendents, principals, vice-principals, and head teachers for which any school district shall be entitled to reimbursement shall be determined by the Territorial Board of Education.

Section 7. Funds to carry out the provisions of this Act may be appropriated in the General Appropriations Bill of the Alaska Legislature.

Section 8. This Act shall become effective July 1, 1957.
