

tendent's, principal's, vice-principal's, head teacher's, or teacher's-in-charge salary shall be determined by the salary scale position of the employed as established by the Territorial Board of Education; and provided further, that no reimbursement shall be made to any school district in Alaska on any salary paid which is less than the scale or any amount which is in excess of the scale established by law. Nothing in this Act shall be construed as prohibiting the employment of a teacher, superintendent, principal, vice-principal, head teacher, or teacher-in-charge at a higher rate than the scale specified in this Act, either by a school district board or the Territorial Board of Education as the operating board for schools outside school districts.

Section 5. Section 37-6-5, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 37-6-5. Statement of Qualifications: Filing: Contents. A statement of the qualifications of each teacher and superintendent employed by the Territorial Board of Education or by a school district shall be filed with the

Commissioner of Education; such statement shall set forth the credits earned in college, normal school or university, and the number of years of teaching experience both in Alaska and elsewhere in such form and manner as may be prescribed by the Commissioner of Education.

Section 6. Section 37-6-6, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 37-6-6. Determination of Number of Teachers, Superintendents, Principals, Vice-Principals, and Head Teachers for Which District Entitled to Reimbursement. The maximum number of teachers, superintendents, principals, vice-principals, and head teachers for which any school district shall be entitled to reimbursement shall be determined by the Territorial Board of Education.

Section 7. Funds to carry out the provisions of this Act may be appropriated in the General Appropriations Bill of the Alaska Legislature.

Section 8. This Act shall become effective July 1, 1957.

CHAPTER 180

AN ACT

To establish the annual salary rates of the Agency and Department heads of the Territorial Government of Alaska; and stating the authority for fixing the salary rates of other Territorial employees; and setting an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. **Legislative Intent.** The annual salary rates of the administrative heads of the various Territorial agencies and departments are presently scattered throughout appropriation acts and other Territorial statutes, making it difficult to search out and evaluate each salary in reference to the others. Also some of the annual salary rates of heads of agencies and departments have been traditionally established by the Legislature, while others have been set by various boards and commissions. It is the intent of this Act to bring all such salaries together in one statute, and at the same time make the Legislature responsible for fixing all such salaries.

Sec. 2. Notwithstanding any salary rates fixed or implied by any Act of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska prior to the effective date of this Act, the following salary rates are established:

Sec. 3. The salary rates of all other Territorial employees shall be as fixed by the administrative head of each agency or as established by the salary plan of the Merit System Council for those agencies coming under the jurisdiction of the Merit System Council.

Sec. 4. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1957.
