

this money is to be equally divided.

(7) For the payment of compensation to such janitors and charwomen as are necessary to clean, care for and keep in proper order the rooms occupied by the Legislature at this session, the sum of \$3,000.00

(8) For the payment of necessary telephone service for use of the Legislature during the present session, the sum of \$88.00

(9) For the preparing of the Senate and House Journals, and the printing and binding of the Session Laws and advance sheets; and for printing and furnishing stationery and other printing for the use of the Legislature during the present session, the sum of \$20,000.00

(10) For the purchase of mimeograph paper, typewriting paper, stencils, carbons and such other material and supplies as may be necessary for the use of the Legislature during the present session, the sum of \$6,300.00

(11) For the payment of per diem in lieu of subsistence at the rate of \$20.00 per day for the members of the Legislature, 62 days each for regular members of both Houses and 71 days for the President of the

Senate and Speaker of the House, the sum of \$49,960.00

(12) For postage allowance of \$100.00 to be paid to each member of the House and Senate, as the estimated amount necessary to defray cost of mailing, telegraphing and otherwise communicating with constituents during this session, the sum of \$4,000.00

(13) For a Contingent Fund to be divided equally by House of Representatives and the Senate for use in defraying cost of extra mailing of a mass nature and hiring of additional help as needed or other contingencies and same to be drawn on by the authority of the Speaker of the House of Representatives or President of the Senate, respectively, the sum of \$4,000.00

Sec. 2. The monies hereby appropriated shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

Sec. 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.

CHAPTER 2

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$360.00 to pay Solveig Xavier for teaching and janitorial services performed for the Territory of Alaska; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$360.00 is hereby appropriated out of monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of paying Solveig Xavier for teaching and janitorial services performed at the Candle Territorial School during the month of November, 1948.

Section 2. Upon the surrender

by Solveig Xavier to the Commissioner of Education of Warrant Numbers 29549 and 29616, dated November 26, 1948, payment of the sum of \$360.00 shall be made on a voucher approved by the Commissioner of Education.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 3

AN ACT

Appropriating the sum of \$98,000 for transportation of school children in the biennium ending June 30, 1957; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 16)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$98,000, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the transportation of school pupils in the Territory for the biennium end-

ing June 30, 1957. This appropriation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for transportation of school pupils during said biennium.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 4

AN ACT

Relating to civil and criminal liability of merchants.

(H. B. 19)
