

CHAPTER 29

AN ACT

Authorizing an appropriation for the expenses of the Alaska members of the advisory committee to the International North Pacific Fisheries Commission for the biennium ending June 30, 1959.

(H. B. 63)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby authorized an appropriation for the sole purpose of defraying the cost of transportation and per diem incurred by the Alaska members of the advisory committee to the International North Pacific Fisheries Commission during attendance at and traveling to and from meet-

ings of the Commission and meetings of the American Section of the Commission during the biennium ending June 30, 1959.

Section 2. Funds to carry out the provisions of this Act may be appropriated in the General Appropriations Act of the Alaska Legislature for disbursement by the Office of the Governor.

CHAPTER 30

AN ACT

Enlarging the period to two years, from the date of the death of a decedent, before allowing an interest charge upon delinquent inheritance tax payments due and owing the Territory, and to amend Sec. 48-4-16, ACLA 1949.

(H. B. 102)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 48-4-16, ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 48-4-16. Interest on Delinquent Tax Payments: Rate. If such tax shall not be paid within two years from the date of the death of the decedent, interest shall thereafter be collected thereon at the rate of seven per

centum until paid, unless, by reason of claims against the estate, necessary litigation or other unavoidable cause of delay, such tax cannot be determined as herein provided; in such case interest, at the rate of six per centum per annum, shall be charged upon such tax until the cause of delay is removed, after which seven per centum shall be charged.
