

CHAPTER 31

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$61.35 to pay Ole Dahl for janitorial services performed for the Territory of Alaska; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 106)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$61.35 is hereby appropriated out of monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of paying Ole Dahl for janitorial services performed at the Talkeetna Territorial School for December, 1956 and January, 1957,

and employer's F.I.C.A. matching contribution. Payment shall be made on a voucher approved by the Commissioner of Education.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 32

AN ACT

Relating to an immediate appropriation for salaries and expenses of the Tennessee Plan Senators and Representative; and declaring an emergency.

(C. S. for H. B. 7)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$185,925.41, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the payment of salaries and expenses of the Alaska Tennessee Plan Senators and Representative for the period commencing January 1, 1957 and ending March 31, 1959, according to the schedule set forth below; Provided, however, that any monies heretofore paid

over by the Alaska Statehood Committee to offset any of the expenses authorized and listed in the items below, with the exception of that item designated as "Public Relations and Miscellaneous", shall reduce the sums allowed herein the amount reduced shall remain in the general fund:
