

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. The sum of \$360.00 is hereby appropriated out of monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of paying Solveig Xavier for teaching and janitorial services performed at the Candle Territorial School during the month of November, 1948.

Section 2. Upon the surrender

by Solveig Xavier to the Commissioner of Education of Warrant Numbers 29549 and 29616, dated November 26, 1948, payment of the sum of \$360.00 shall be made on a voucher approved by the Commissioner of Education.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 3

### AN ACT

**Appropriating the sum of \$98,000 for transportation of school children in the biennium ending June 30, 1957; and declaring an emergency.**

(H. B. 16)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. The sum of \$98,000, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the transportation of school pupils in the Territory for the biennium end-

ing June 30, 1957. This appropriation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for transportation of school pupils during said biennium.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 4

### AN ACT

**Relating to civil and criminal liability of merchants.**

(H. B. 19)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. The term "merchant" as used herein shall mean an owner or operator, and the agent, consignee, employee, lessee, or officer of an owner or operator, of any merchant's premises. The term "premises" shall mean any establishment or part thereof wherein merchandise is displayed, held or offered for sale. The term "merchandise" shall mean any personal property, capable of manual delivery, displayed, held or offered for

sale by a merchant.

Section 2. Any merchant shall have the right to request any individual on his premises to place or keep in full view any merchandise such individual may have removed, or which the merchant believes he may have removed, from its place of display or elsewhere, whether for examination, purchase, or for any other purpose. No merchant shall be criminally or civilly liable for having made such a request.

## CHAPTER 5

### AN ACT

**To appropriate the sum of \$33,456.00 to the Department of Public Welfare to be expended for expenses and deficits occurring in certain programs during January and February of 1957; and declaring an emergency.**

(H. B. 52)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. **Appropriation of \$33,456.00 to the Department of Public Welfare.** The sum of \$33,456.00 is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Welfare out of monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, and shall be expended for expenses and deficits occurring in the following programs for the months of January and February, 1957:

\$20,046.00—General Relief—Medical Care Program—to restore percentage reductions in hospital and nursing home payments.

\$13,410.00—Juvenile Code—to restore percentage reductions in boarding care payments.

Section 2. **Money to be expended in normal manner.** The above monies shall be in addition to all other monies appropriated to the Department of Public Welfare and shall be disbursed and expended in the same manner and in accordance with the same procedures as monies are normally expended for said programs.

Section 3. **Emergency.** An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
