

- (4) Loss of consortium.
- (5) Loss of prospective training and education.
- (6) Medical and funeral expenses.
- The death of a beneficiary or

beneficiaries before judgment shall not affect the amount of damages recoverable hereunder.

The right of action hereby granted shall not be abated by the death of a person named or to be named the defendant.

CHAPTER 7

AN ACT

Relating to the recording and filing of Territorial tax liens by U. S. Commissioners.

(S. B. 7)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. File and Index. A permanent separate file and index shall be maintained by U. S. Commissioners in each recording district or precinct for the recording of all Territorial tax liens.

Sec. 2. Contents of Index. The index shall set forth in alphabetical

order the names of those persons against whom any Territorial tax liens have been filed.

Sec. 3. Use as Evidence. The recording of such liens in the proper precincts duly certified by the Commissioner shall be evidence in all courts in the Territory and shall have the same effect as the original.

CHAPTER 8

AN ACT

Amending Section 7 (1) of Ch. 124, SLA 1951, requiring a filing fee to accompany any lien document filed with the Department of Taxation; and setting an effective date.

(S. B. 20)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska.

Section 1: Two (\$2.00) Dollar Filing Fee Required, Section 7 (1)

of Ch. 124, SLA 1951 is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (c) to read as follows:

(c) A filing fee of Two (\$2.00) dollars shall accompany every lien document of whatever nature

filed with the Department as provided herein.

Sec. 2. An effective date is hereby established, and this Act shall take effect on April 1, 1957.

CHAPTER 9

AN ACT

Amending Section 57-7-1, ACLA 1949, concerning the condemnation of property for oil and gas facilities.

(H. B. 60)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 57-7-1, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (12), to read as follows:

(12) For the location of pipe

lines for gathering, transmitting, transporting, storing or delivering of natural or artificial gas or oil or any liquid or gaseous hydrocarbons, including, but not limited to, pumping stations, terminals, storage tanks or reservoirs and related installations.

CHAPTER 10

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$3,989.93 for the printing and binding of the Senate and House Journals of the Twenty-Second Session of the Territorial Legislature; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 17)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$3,989.93 or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the General

Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the completion of payment for the printing and binding of the Senate and House Journals of the Twenty-Second Session of the Territorial Legislature. This appropriation shall be in addition to
