

CHAPTER 79

AN ACT

Authorizing the Executive Director of the Legislative Council to transfer the sum of \$2,125.00 available in the biennial appropriation for the Legislative Council from an item containing a surplus to items where there is a deficiency; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 135)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Executive Director of the Legislative Council is hereby authorized and empowered to transfer the sum of \$2,125.00 available from the 1955-57 appropriation for Legislative Council for "Travel and Per Diem for Council Members" for the following purposes:

To cover deficiency in appropriation for:

- 1. Director's Salary ..\$ 400.00
- 2. Staff Salaries 340.00
- 3. Travel and per diem for Director 160.00

- 4. Contingent, Equipment and Office Expense 1,200.00
- 5. F.I.C.A. 25.00

Sec. 2. No transfer of funds, as above authorized, will be effective for vouchering purposes unless and until the Director of Finance has been officially notified thereof in writing.

Sec. 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 80

AN ACT

To provide for reimbursements for special expenditures made in the course of authorized investigations as provided by the Alaska Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act; amending Sec. 22, Ch. 129, SLA 1949.

(H. B. 156)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Sec. 22, Ch. 129, SLA 1949, is hereby amended by adding the following new Subsection (3) thereto:

(3) The Department of Health is hereby authorized to make expenditures from monies appropriated for the administration of the Alaska Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, to reimburse authorized employees or agents for

amounts expended without receipt, covering purchases or services obtained in securing evidence of a violation of this Act, upon vouchers certified by the

disbursing and certifying officers of the Department. Disbursements authorized herein shall not exceed Eight Hundred (\$800.00) Dollars in any biennium.

CHAPTER 81

AN ACT

To pay to Martha M. Turner, of Santa Rosa, California, the sum of \$276.43, escheated from the estate of Fred Sever, deceased; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 157)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of monies in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$276.43 to pay to Martha M. Turner, of Santa Rosa, California, sister and sole

heir of Fred Sever, deceased, \$276.43 being the exact amount escheated to the Territory from the estate of Fred Sever, deceased.

Sec. 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 82

AN ACT

Relating to the pay periods of Territorial officers and employees; repealing and re-enacting Sec. 11-3-7, ACLA 1949; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 160)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Sec. 11-3-7, ACLA 1949, is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 11-3-7. Time For and Com-

putation of Payment: Deductions for Absence. Officers and employees of the Territory shall be paid for such periods and at such times as may be prescribed by the Director of Finance. Any person entering or leaving the
