

## HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. 13

**To the Honorable Waino Hendrickson, Acting Governor of Alaska; the Territorial Highway Engineer; the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners; and the Bureau of Public Roads:**

Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska in Twenty-third Regular Session assembled, respectfully submits that:

WHEREAS, Alaska's participation in the Federal-Aid Highway Program authorizes the construction and maintenance of highways through cities; and

WHEREAS, most of the monies for the Highway Fund are levied and collected within cities from motorists who use city streets; and

WHEREAS, cities receive no re-

funds or other direct assistance from highway revenues; and

WHEREAS, adequate construction, reconstruction and maintenance of highways through cities has been financially oppressive on city taxpayers and frequently not carried out at all due to lack of sufficient municipal funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska, in regular session of the Twenty-third Legislature assembled, respectfully urges that cities be allocated a portion of the funds and other adequate arrangements be made to assist cities in the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of highways within cities.

## HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. 14

**To the Honorable Executive Officers and Members of the National Science Service.**

Service has recognized the tremendous growth of the Territory of Alaska and its progress towards statehood by granting the public schools of Alaska the opportunity to affiliate with and to take part in the program of this national organization,

NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska in Twenty-Third Session assembled takes notice of such recognition by the National Science Service and hereby extends an invitation to it to hold a future National Science Fair in Alaska.
