

Senate Joint Resolutions

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

Be it Resolved by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska in Twenty-Third Session Assembled:

WHEREAS, it is apparent that \$50,000.00 of that portion of the 1955-57 appropriation for the operation of the Pioneers' Home allocated for "General Expense" will revert to the General Fund on and after June 30, 1957; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the amount allocated to "Salaries" will fall short some \$15,000.00 due to increased help made necessary by the opening-up of the "Women's Wing", and further that some \$35,000.00 is required to cover the cost of renovating the "Pioneers' Home Kitchen" and installing

needed new equipment therein

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska direct that \$15,000.00 of said "Maintenance Fund" be transferred into the "Salary" allocation, and \$35,000.00 thereof be set aside to cover the cost of renovating said kitchen and installing new equipment, the said latter amount so much thereof as may be necessary to be expended under the supervision of the Board of Trustees of said Home.

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

Be it Resolved by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska in Twenty-Third Session Assembled:

WHEREAS, the total cost of construction of the proposed Juvenile Home in Ketchikan is estimated to be \$71,692.00; and

WHEREAS, there remains in the 1955-1957 appropriation for the construction of Juvenile Homes only the unexpended balance of \$57,393.00; and

WHEREAS, it is apparent that the sum of \$33,562.20 of the 1955-1957 line appropriation for the support of Juvenile Homes will revert

to the General Fund after June 30, 1957;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-Third Session assembled, that \$15,000.00 of said appropriation for the support of Juvenile Homes be transferred into the construction appropriation to cover the balance of the proposed cost of the construction of a Juvenile Home in Ketchikan.
