

CHAPTER 9

AN ACT

Relating to the furnishing of contractual services, materials and supplies to municipalities of the first class; amending Sec. 16-1-35, ACLA 1949 and more specifically that sub-paragraph designated as "twenty-ninth", added by Ch. 124, SLA 1957; and setting an effective date.

(S.B. 23)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. Sec. 16-1-35, ACLA 1949 and more specifically that sub-paragraph designated "twenty-ninth", as added by Ch. 124, SLA 1957 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Thirtieth: Every person, business association or legal entity, except an agency of federal, state or local government, furnishing, or bidding to furnish, contractual services, materials or supplies to any municipality of the first class shall have a valid Alaska Business License. All sealed bids and

invoices for the furnishing of such services, materials or supplies shall contain the serial number of the vendor's Alaska Business License, the type of business for which the license was issued, and the date of issuance. No contract shall be awarded, nor shall any invoice be paid upon any bid or invoice that does not contain such information, or upon the bid or invoice of any person or firm which does not have a valid Alaska Business License.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.

CHAPTER 10

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$8,781.63 out of the General Fund not otherwise appropriated for the purchase of equipment and for the payment of alterations made in the Senate and House Chambers; and setting an effective date.

(H.B. 3)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. **Appropriation.** The sum of \$8,781.63 is hereby appropriated out of monies in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated for the payment of:

Désks and Chairs (for the House)	\$5,925.29
Coat Racks	151.50
Wall Clocks	54.00
Alterations	1,315.84

writers 1,335.00

Sec. 2. **Manner of Payment.** Such monies shall be paid by the Director of Finance on invoices duly prepared, presented to and a voucher properly certified by the legislative fiscal officer.

Sec. 3. **Unencumbered Balances.** All unencumbered balances herein shall revert to the General Fund.

Sec. 4. **Effective Date.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
