CHAPTER 131

AN ACT

Authorizing the Pioneers' Home to transfer the sum of \$10,506.47 plus interest at the rate of 2% from December 11, 1958, from an unobligated balance remaining in the item "Operation and Maintenance of Home" to the payment of balance due on the construction of the 79-bed Pioneers' Home addition; and providing an effective date.

(H.B. 220)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The Pioneers' Home is hereby authorized to transfer, the sum of \$10,506.47 plus interest thereon at the rate of 2% from December 11, 1958, until paid, from the unobligated balance in the item of the Pioneers' Home for "Operation and Maintenance of Home" to the

payment of the balance due to the United States Department of the Interior, Alaska Public Works, for the construction of the 79-bed Pioneers' home addition, Sitka, Alaska, Project No. Aaa. 50-A-175.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.

CHAPTER 132

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$1,500 for expenses of the Banking Board for the biennium ending June 30, 1959; and providing for an effective date.

(S.B. 127)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$1,500 is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated to the Banking Board for the purpose of paying the expenses of a bank examiner during the biennium ending June 30,

1959. This appropriation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for the above purpose during said biennium.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.

To appropriate the sum of \$1,150 for expenses of the Board of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture Examiners for the biennium ending June 30, 1959; and providing

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$1,150 is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated to the Board of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture Examiners for the purpose of paying salaries and other expenses dur-

ing the biennium ending June 30, 1959. This appropriation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for the above purposes during said biennium.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.

CHAPTER 134

AN ACT

Pertaining to motor vehicle registration; amending subsections (1) and (2), of Sec. 4, Ch. 124, SLA 1951, as amended by Ch. 50, SLA 1953, Ch. 37, SLA 1955 and Ch. 176, SLA 1957; and providing for an effective date.

(C.S.H.B. 58)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. Subsections (1) and (2) of Sec. 4, Ch. 124, SLA 1951 as amended by Ch. 50, SLA 1953, Ch. 37, SLA 1955, and Ch. 176, SLA 1957 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4. Annual License Tax.

(1) **Levy and Rate of Tax.** For the privilege of driving or moving any vehicle subject to registration under this Act upon any highway in the State there is hereby levied an annual license tax. Such tax shall be at the rates specified in this section and shall be paid to and collected by the department at the time of making application for registration, or annual renewal of registration, as provided in this Act.

(a) For every motorcycle, \$10.00.

(b) For every private motor vehicle including $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{3}{4}$ ton trucks not used, or maintained primarily for the transportation of passengers or property for hire, \$20.00. For the purpose of this subsection, a "private motor vehicle" includes a vehicle used or maintained primarily for personal transportation and for the transportation of his personal property.

(c) For every motor vehicle for

hire, operated and known as a taxicab, \$40.00.

(d) For every commercial motor vehicle, including motor vehicles pulling trailers, semi-trailers or trucks designed, used or maintained primarily for the transportation of passengers for hire, excepting taxicabs, or for the transportation or hauling of property, including without limitation, such commercial vehicles as wreckers, or tow cars, hearses, ambulances, and tractors, the actual combined weight as established by the manufacturer's advertised weight, or if not so determined, it shall be the responsibility of the owner to furnish the true and actual weight, subject to the approval of the commissioner or his agent, of which is:

12,000 pounds or less\$50.00

Provided that motor buses of twenty or more seating capacity used exclusively for commercial purposes in the transporting of transient visitors and tourists shall be included in this classification.

12,001 pounds and not over
18,000 pounds\$100.00

18,001 pounds and over\$150.00

For the purpose of this subsection, a "Commercial motor vehicle" is a
