WHEREAS, concurrence for adjournment and adjournment sine die at the

end of the second regular session of a legislature is required by Rules 79 and 80 of the Uniform Rules of Procedure;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Second Regular Session of the First State Legislature adjourn sine die no later than midnight, Pacific Standard Time, March 29, 1960.
