

## CHAPTER 30

## AN ACT

**Appropriating from the Water and Harbor Facilities Fund and from the aviation fuel tax account in the general fund to the Department of Public Works for certain projects; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 260)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. The sum of \$177,000 is appropriated from the Water and Harbor Facilities Fund and the sum of \$73,000 is appropriated from the aviation fuel tax account in the general fund to the Division of

Water and Harbor Facilities, Department of Public Works for projects in Cordova, Hoonah, Wrangell and Petersburg.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

## CHAPTER 31

## AN ACT

**Relating to the Fish and Game Code of Alaska; amending Sec. 6 of Art. I, Ch. 94, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date.**

(S.B. 110)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. The first two paragraphs of Sec. 6, Art. I, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 are amended to read as follows:

Sec. 6. **The Board of Fish and Game: Tenure: Powers.** There shall be a Board of Fish and Game composed of ten members having a general knowledge of the fish and game resources of the State and selected without regard to political affiliation or special interest. They shall be United States citizens and residents of Alaska as herein defined. The members of the Board shall be appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by a majority of the members of the Legislature in joint session.

Each shall serve a four-year term,

provided that the first members appointed hereunder shall serve as follows: two members shall serve for one year, two for two years, two for three years, and two for four years, respectively; provided, that the ninth and tenth members appointed under this Act shall serve terms of two and four years, respectively. Initial terms shall date from the first of February immediately preceding appointment. In case a vacancy shall occur on the Board, the Governor shall fill the same by appointment for the unexpired term, which appointment shall be submitted to the Legislature for confirmation at the next regular or special session.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

## CHAPTER 32

## AN ACT

**Appropriating from the federal transitional grant account in the general fund; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 263)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. The sum of \$267,150 is appropriated from the federal transitional grant account in the general fund to the Department of Public Works, Division of Aviation,

for capital improvements at the Fairbanks and Anchorage International airports.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

## CHAPTER 33

### AN ACT

**Appropriating refunds of the proceeds of the coin operated device tax to municipalities; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 119)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. The sum of \$38,648.00 is appropriated from the general fund to the following municipalities in the listed amounts as refunds of a portion of the coin operated devices tax earned within such municipalities according to the provisions of Sec. 48-3-6, ACLA 1949 as repealed and re-enacted by Sec. 6, Ch. 142, SLA 1960:

## CHAPTER 34

### AN ACT

**Transferring between appropriations made to certain agencies for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 141)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. The sum of \$1,750 is transferred to the line appropriation Division of Tourism and Economic Development from the line appropriation for Personal Services, Departmental Operation, Department of Commerce, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961.

Sec. 2. The sum of \$2,000 is transferred to the line appropriation for travel made to the Division of Fire Prevention, Department of Public Safety, from the line appropriation for personal service, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
