

CHAPTER 35

AN ACT

**Appropriating from the general fund and from federal transitional grants in the general fund to the Department of Public Works; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 151)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. The sum of \$320,650.00 is appropriated from the general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961, according to the following schedule:

Sec. 2. The sum of \$156,450.00 is appropriated from the federal transitional grants in the general fund according to the following schedule:

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 36

AN ACT

**Regarding the support of schools in newly incorporated first or second class cities; amending Ch. 90, SLA 1960; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 124)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. Ch. 90, SLA 1960, is amended to read:

Sec. 1. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, in the event that any previously unincorporated area or city of the fourth class served by a totally state supported school or schools voluntarily incorporates as a city of the first or second class, the responsibility of the state for the continued support of the

local schools in the newly incorporated area shall be as follows:

(1) For the first fiscal year of operation beginning on July 1 following the incorporation, the state shall pay from appropriations available for support of schools outside incorporated districts, 100% of the budget approved by the commissioner of education pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 37-3-63, ACLA 1949 as amended or as hereafter amended. Local expenditures above the level of the approved budget may be made by the
