CHAPTER 44

AN ACT

Transferring between certain line item appropriations made for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 275)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$3,000 is transferred from the line item appropriation for personal services, Division of Civil Defense, Department of Public Safety, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961, to the following line item appropriations:

- (1) To Travel, Civil Defense \$ 1,000
- (2) To Commodities, Civil Defense \$ 2,000

Sec. 2. The sum of \$2,000 is transferred from the line item appropriation made for personal services, Division of Fire Prevention, Department of Public Safety, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961, to the line item appropriation for contractual services, Division of State Police, Department of Public Safety.

Sec. 3. The sum of \$3,000 is transferred from the line item appropriation made for personal services, Division of State Police, Department of Public Safety, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961, to the line item appropriation for contractual services, Division of State Police.

Sec. 4. The sum of \$17,500 is transferred from the line item appropriation for care of prisoners made to the Division of Youth and Adult Authority, Department of Health and Welfare, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961, to be used by that division

for the repair and improvement of state jail facilities during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961.

Sec. 5. The following line item transfers are made among the appropriations made to the Commercial Fisheries Division, Department of Fish and Game for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961:

- (1) From contractual services to personal services: \$14,700
- (2) From contractual services to equipment: \$ 200
- (3) From travel to equipment: \$ 3,350
- (3) From commodities, to equipment: \$ 5,850
- (5) From commodities to meet supplemental expenses of the Alaska Advisors to the American Section of the International North Pacific Fisheries Commission: \$ 2,100

Sec. 6. The following line item transfers are made among the appropriations made to the Protection Division, Department of Fish and Game for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961:

- (1) From personal services to land and structures: \$ 3,000

- (2) From personal services to contractual services: \$29,000
- (3) From personal services to equipment: \$23,000

- (4) From travel to commodities: \$45,000

Appropriating from federal transitional grants; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 281)

CHAPTER 46

AN ACT

Making certain appropriations; and providing an effective date.

(H.B. 272)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$752.25 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse the Daily Alaska Empire for expenses incurred by the state prior to January 1, 1959.

Fairbanks Independent School District for expenses incurred for vocational education pursuant to an agreement with the state during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960.

Sec. 2. The sum of \$142.20 is appropriated from the general fund to the Legislative Council to reimburse Ellis Airlines for travel expenses incurred by the state during the biennium ending June 30, 1959.

Sec. 5. The sum of \$66.33 is appropriated from the general fund to the Board of Nursing to pay expenses of the board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959.
