

## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 27

**Relating to the Honorable Clarence F. Pautzke.**

**Be It Resolved by the House in Second Legislature, First Session Assembled, the Senate Concurring:**

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has announced that the Honorable Clarence F. Pautzke, now Deputy Commissioner of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, will be appointed the Commissioner of the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Department of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Pautzke has worked diligently and effectively in the service of the State of Alaska during these early and demanding months of statehood, and is held in high esteem by his colleagues and the people of Alaska; and
