CHAPTER 128

AN ACT

Relating to the salaries of heads of principal departments; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 495)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 105, SLA 1959, is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Section 1. The head of each principal executive department of the state upon appointment and qualification shall receive an annual salary as determined by the governor, but the department head shall not receive a salary in excess of the amount set opposite titles listed below:
