

## CHAPTER 65

## AN ACT

To provide for the service of process relating to attachment by person specially appointed by the court.

(H.B. 215)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. Service of all process relat-

ing to attachment may be made by a person specially appointed by the court for that purpose.

## CHAPTER 66

## AN ACT

Relating to district magistrates; amending Sec. 17(1), Ch. 184, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 248)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. Sec. 17(1), Ch. 184, SLA 1959, is amended to read:

(1) Each district magistrate shall receive annual compensation to be de-

termined by the supreme court, but in any event not to exceed \$12,750. Such compensation shall be payable annually in twelve equal monthly installments.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

## CHAPTER 67

## AN ACT

Appropriating to the board of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 308)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$1,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the board of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture for the

fiscal year ending June 30, 1962.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

## CHAPTER 68

## AN ACT

Appropriating to the University of Alaska; and providing for an effective date.

(C.S.H.B. 311)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$378,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Uni-

versity of Alaska to cover the costs of completing the university gymnasium.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

## CHAPTER 69

### AN ACT

**Appropriating money to pay an indebtedness to teaching personnel in Klawock School District; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 379)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. The sum of \$3,542.48 is appropriated from the general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962, to the Department of Education for the repayment of indebtedness incurred in the school year 1953-1954 by the Klawock School District to the following teaching personnel in the following amounts:

Izetta Draper .....	488.96
Marion McClenny .....	520.00
Conrad Potter .....	475.60
Robert J. Peratrovich .....	475.60
Arthur J. Demmert .....	553.36
Rolland L. Bennett .....	486.72

## CHAPTER 70

### AN ACT

**Transferring between certain line item appropriations made for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 478)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. The sum of \$531 is transferred from the line item appropriation for commodities, division of civil defense, Department of Public Safety, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962, to the line item appropriation for contractual services, division of civil defense, Department of Public Safety.

Sec. 2. The sum of \$1700 is transferred from the line item appropriation for personal services, division of state police, Department of Public Safety, for the fiscal

year ending June 30, 1962, to the line item appropriation for contractual services, division of state police, Department of Public Safety.

Sec. 3. The sum of \$1562.98 is transferred from the line item appropriation for travel and per diem, division of state police, Department of Public Safety, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962, to the line item appropriation for contractual services, division of state police, Department of Public Safety.

Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
