

CHAPTER 94

AN ACT

Relating to motor vehicle registration; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 458)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. Sec. 3 (13), Ch. 124, SLA 1951, is amended to read:

(13) **Renewal of Registration.** Application for renewal of a vehicle registration shall be made by the owner upon proper application and by payment of the annual license tax for such vehicle as provided by this Act. The commissioner may receive applications for registration or renewal registration and grant the same and issue new registration cards and plates at any time prior to expiration of registration, but no person shall display upon a vehicle the new registration plates prior to February 15 of the year in which such plates are issued.

Sec. 2. Sec. 4(3), Ch. 124, SLA 1951, as amended by Sec. 1, Ch. 176, SLA 1957, is amended to read:

(3) **Reduced Fee for Portion of Year.**

Whenever a motor vehicle, trailer, or semi-trailer subject to registration under this Act is registered on or after the first day of December of any year, the tax shall be one-half the annual license tax imposed hereunder; provided, however, that such vehicle shall not have been illegally operated on the highways of the state prior to December 1 of the year in which application for registration is made.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 95

AN ACT

Appropriating \$2,331.50 to the Department of Public Safety for reimbursement of expenses incurred by the United States Department of the Army and the Bachner Company in flood control; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 467)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$1,754 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Public Safety to reimburse the United States Department of the Army for the cost of blasting materials used in breaking up a dangerous ice jam in the Anchor River area during the period January 25 through January 28, 1961.

Sec. 2. The sum of \$577.50 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Public Safety to reimburse the Bachner Company for the use of a backhoe used in flood control in the De Barr Road area near Anchorage during January 1962.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
