

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. AS 16.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

**Sec. 16.35.180. Bounty Not to Be Paid.** (a) No bounty may be paid under secs. 140 — 180 of this chapter to a person who is not a resident of the state, or to a salaried employee of a federal

or state agency which is engaged in fish or game protection, management or research activity.

(b) For the purposes of this section, "resident" means a person who, for the immediately preceding year, has maintained a permanent place of abode inside the state, and who has continually maintained his legal residence in the state.

CHAPTER 20

AN ACT

**Designating the king salmon as the official fish of the state.**

(H.B. 97)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. AS 44.09 is amended by add-

ing a new section to read:

**Sec. 44.09.080. State Fish.** The king salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*) is the official fish of the state.

CHAPTER 21

AN ACT

**Appropriating \$3,600 from the general fund to Joe E. Swain in payment of a workmen's compensation award; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 126)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. The sum of \$3,600 is appropriated from the general fund to compensate Joe E. Swain, pursuant to an award by the Alaska Workmen's Compensation Board, for loss of earning capacity resulting from an injury received by him while

on duty as a trooper of the Department of Territorial Police of Alaska.

Sec. 2. The amount appropriated by this Act shall be paid on vouchers certified by the governor.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 22

AN ACT

**Appropriating for legislative expenses; and providing for an effective date.**

(S.B. 182)
