

## CHAPTER 55

## AN ACT

**Providing for the transfer of functions relating to the operation of motor vehicle weighing stations from the Department of Public Works to the Department of Commerce, Public Service Commission, Division of Motor Transportation, under Executive Order No. 21.**

(S.B. 159)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. AS 19.10.060(1) is amended to read:

(1) establish limitations on weight and load of vehicles;

Sec. 2. AS 44.33.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(9) operate motor vehicle weighing stations and enforce highway weight and load limitations.

Sec. 3. AS 28.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 28.05.025. **Authority of the Public Service Commission to Adopt Rules and Regulations.** The Public Service Commission is responsible for the operation of motor vehicle weighing stations, and the enforcement of highway weight and load limitations. The commission shall adopt rules and regulations necessary for the operation of motor vehicle weighing stations, and regulations necessary to enforce weight and load limitations on state highways.

## CHAPTER 56

## AN ACT

**Relating to estrays; and providing for an effective date.**

(S.C.S.H.B. 26)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. AS 03.50 is repealed.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

## CHAPTER 57

## AN ACT

**Relating to the issuance of \$2,200,000 of general obligation bonds of the state authorized for a vocational education school; providing rules and standards to be followed in determining the specific capital improvements to be acquired, constructed, installed, and made out of the proceeds of sale of such bonds; creating a construction fund and making an appropriation of \$2,200,000 therefrom; creating a bond redemption fund; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 58)

**Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**
