

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 22

Relating to the need for a school at McGrath.

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives:

WHEREAS the school facility at McGrath must be used by the people living in nearby communities which do not have schools; and

WHEREAS the expanding school population of McGrath itself and the additional students moving in from nearby villages are overtaxing the already inadequate school facility there; and

WHEREAS the present school facility is

overcrowded, poorly heated and lighted, and does not have indoor sanitation facilities; and

WHEREAS McGrath was promised a new or expanded school facility last year under the school bonding program, but no action has been taken thus far;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the Department of Education and the Department of Public Works to take immediate action to alleviate the desperate situation in McGrath with regard to its school facility.
