

CHAPTER 100

AN ACT

Appropriating for extraordinary expenditures of state funds to meet the effects of the natural disaster of March 27, 1964; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 454)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$2,200,000 is appropriated from the Federal Transitional Grants Account in the general fund for payment of extraordinary expenses incurred by the state to meet the effects of the natural disaster of March 27, 1964.

Sec. 2. This sum is available to pay part or all of any obligation incurred or expenditure made from March 27, 1964, and shall be available until June 30, 1965.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 101

AN ACT

Relating to expenditure and accounting of funds disbursed from the Federal Transitional Grants Account in the general fund; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 455)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The purpose of this Act is to insure that funds granted by Congress to assist the state in meeting the natural disaster of March 27, 1964, are allocated and used for the purposes intended by Congress.

Sec. 2. The commissioner of administration shall disburse funds appropriated from the Federal Transitional Grants Account for the purposes for which said funds were intended by Congress to be used.

Sec. 3. Funds appropriated from the Federal Transitional Grants Account for payment to municipalities and school districts to meet shortfalls in revenue caused by the natural disaster of March 27, 1964, shall be disbursed by the commissioner of administration. No funds shall be disbursed under this Act until the municipality or school district in

need of funds because of shortfall in revenue applies to the commissioner of administration in a manner to be prescribed by him. Municipalities and school districts receiving funds under this Act shall account to the commissioner of administration for the expenditure of the funds. Before disbursing funds to municipalities or school districts from the Federal Transitional Grants Account, the commissioner of administration may require a written agreement with the municipalities or school districts relating to the expenditure and accounting for the funds.

Sec. 4. The commissioner of administration is authorized to disburse to municipalities and school districts in an amount not to exceed \$3,200,000 for the purposes authorized in this Act.

Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
