

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 45

Relating to the University of Alaska entering into an agreement regarding sewerage plant and service.

Be it Resolved by the Senate:

WHEREAS the Legislature recognizes the University of Alaska is in need of additional sewerage facility, by demand of the Public Health Service, for the present and to keep pace with the needs of a growing student population; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska earthquake on March 27, 1964 has caused the need for immediate financing for other purposes, including capital construction not connected with the University; and

WHEREAS the College Utilities Corporation, an Alaskan corporation, has agreed to construct such a sewerage plant and to furnish service in an amount which present estimates indicate would be far less than the cost to the University both for capital construction and

operation, all for the reason that such a sewerage plant will also serve the community of College, Alaska, and other political subdivisions;

BE IT RESOLVED that approval is given to the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska to enter into an agreement regarding a sewerage plant and service to handle all sewerage disposal for a period not to exceed 15 years; provided that under no circumstances shall the University of Alaska be required to pay any costs or charges different from those charged public subdivisions and local residents for like service in the College area under rates now or hereafter authorized by the Public Service Commission; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to each member of the Board of Regents and the President of the University of Alaska.
