

## CHAPTER 14

## AN ACT

**Prohibiting restrictions on the right of a teacher to comment and criticize public officials and employees.**

(H.B. 26)

**Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. AS 14.20 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:

Sec. 14.20.095. **Right to Comment and Criticize Not to be Restricted.** No rule or regulation of the commissioner of education, a local school board, or local

school administrator may restrict or modify the right of a teacher to engage in comment and criticism outside school hours, relative to school administrators, members of the governing body of any school or school district, any other public official, or any school employee, to the same extent that any private individual may exercise the right.

## CHAPTER 15

## AN ACT

**Relating to drift gill net and set or stake gill net licenses; and providing for an effective date.**

(S.B. 9)

**Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. AS 16.05.540 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.540. **Limitation on Issuance of Fishing Gear Licenses.** The fishing gear licenses mentioned in secs. 550 - 650 of this chapter shall be issued one to the applicant. Each applicant shall personally operate or assist in the operation of the licensed fishing gear. Each applicant for the fishing gear licenses mentioned in secs. 570 and 580 of this chapter shall also personally own or lease the licensed fishing gear. The license is transferable as provided under sec. 670 of this chapter.

Sec. 2. AS 16.05.670(a) is amended to read:

(a) A fishing gear license issued under secs. 550, 560, and 590 - 650 of this chapter may be transferred only if sickness, injury, death, unavailability or other incapacitation of the licensee keep or may keep a commercial fishing vessel in port because of the lack of other licensed fishing gear to take its place. A fishing gear license issued under secs. 570 and 580 of this chapter may be transferred only if sickness, injury, or death of the licensee keep or may keep a commercial fishing vessel in port because of the lack of other licensed fishing gear to take its place.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

## CHAPTER 16

## AN ACT

**Amending the manner of designating a lode claim location.**

(S.B. 65)

**Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. AS 27.10.030 is amended to read:

Sec. 27.10.030. **Manner of Designating a Lode Claim Location.** The discoverer of a lode claim shall designate the location as follows:

(1) by posting at the northeast corner of the claim a plain sign or notice containing

- (A) the name of the lode claim;
- (B) the name of the locator or locators;
- (C) the date of the location;

(D) the approximate bearings of corners and angle posts of the claim and the distances between them; and

(2) by erecting at each corner or angle of the claim substantial monuments of stone or setting posts, not less than three feet in height nor less than three inches in diameter hewn and marked with the name of the claim, the position or number of the monument and the direction of the boundary lines, and by cutting out, blazing or marking the boundary lines so that they can be readily traced. Where it is impracticable to place a monument in its true position, a witness monument shall be erected and marked to indicate the true position of the corner or angle.

## CHAPTER 17

### AN ACT

**Relating to the recording of testimony during workmen's compensation hearings.**

(H.B. 11)

**Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. AS 23.30.135(b) is amended to read:

(b) All testimony given during a hearing before the board shall be recorded, but need not be transcribed unless further review is initiated. Hearings before the board shall be open to the public.

## CHAPTER 18

### AN ACT

**Allowing national or state banks located within the State of Alaska to act as executors or administrators of estates of less than \$75,000 without giving bond; and providing for an effective date.**

(H.B. 38)

**Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:**

Section 1. AS 13.20.120 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 13.20.120. **When Bond or Undertaking Required.** (a) No executor or files with the judge having jurisdiction

administrator may act as such until he of the estate an undertaking in a sum not less than equal the probable value of the estate, with one or more sufficient sureties to be approved by the judge, to be void upon condition that the executor or administrator faithfully performs the duties of his trust according to law.
