AN ACT

Relating to the making of public buildings and facilities accessible to, and usable by, the physically handicapped; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 35.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 35.10.015. ARCHITECTURAL BARRIER REGULATIONS.

The Department of Public Works is responsible for preparing and promulgating regulations governing the construction of public buildings and facilities by or for the state and its political subdivisions to insure that the public buildings and facilities are accessible to, and usable by, the physically handicapped. The regulations of the department shall conform as far as it is feasible to the publication entitled "American Standard Specifications for Making Buildings and Facilities Accessible to and Usable by the Physically Handicapped" or any amendments to this publication as approved by the American Standards Association, Incorporated, under the sponsorship of the National Society for Crippled Children and Adults and the President's Committee on

Employment of the Physically Handicapped.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1967.
