## AN ACT

Relating to pay increments for State employees assigned to remote locations; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 39.27 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 39.27.020. PAY INCREMENTS IN REMOTE LOCATIONS.

The following pay increments are approved under AS 39.25.150(2) as an amendment to the pay plan for employees of the state.

(1) Permanent employees assigned to permanent duty stations at locations more than one hundred miles from the Ketchikan, Juneau, Anchorage, or Fairbanks city boundary and which are accessible to one of the above cities by road, railroad, or ferry shall be paid at a rate three per cent above the pay provided by sec. 10 of this chapter.

(2) Permanent employees assigned to permanent duty stations at locations which are not accessible to Ketchikan, Juneau, Anchorage, or Fairbanks by road, railroad,

or ferry shall be paid at a rate six per cent above the pay provided by sec. 10 of this chapter.

(3) The commissioner of administration shall promulgate regulations designating permanent duty stations which are eligible for pay increments under this section.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 16, 1966.
