AN ACT

Relating to the branding of reindeer, bison and muskox.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 03.40.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 03.40.010. BRANDS AND MARKS. Any person owning cattle, reindeer, bison, muskox, sheep, horses, mules or asses, may adopt a brand or mark. After recording the brand or mark as provided in sec. 30 of this chapter, the person has the exclusive right to its use.

* Sec. 2. AS 03.40.050 is amended to read:

Sec. 03.40.050. USE WITHOUT CERTIFICATE PROHIBITED. It is unlawful to brand any horse, cattle, reindeer, bison, muskox, mule or ass, unless the person using the brand holds a written certificate of acceptance from the commissioner.
