AN ACT

Relating to the availability to the public of records kept by the Alaska State Development Corporation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 44.59.150 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.59.150. ANNUAL REPORT AND PUBLIC RECORDS.

(a) Before December 1 of each year, the board shall submit to the governor and the legislature a comprehensive report describing the operations, fiscal transactions, financial condition, and future plans of the board. The governor may prescribe the form of the report.

(b) The board shall maintain the following records which shall be available to the public:

- (1) the names of the business concerns, to whom contracts are let and for whom financing is arranged by the corporation;
- (2) the nature of the business;
- (3) the amount involved.
