AN ACT

Requiring approval of urban renewal and redevelopment plans by ordinance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 18.55.530(1) is amended to read:

(1) Following the hearing, the governing body may by ordinance initially approve a redevelopment plan if it finds that the plan is feasible and conforms with the general plan for the physical development of the area. Approval of subsequent modifications of the plan which do not involve substantive changes shall be by resolution. A redevelopment plan which has not been approved by the governing body when recommended by the authority may again be recommended to it with any modifications considered advisable.
