AN ACT

Relating to the licensing of doctors of osteopathy under AS 08.64; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.64 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 08.64.205. QUALIFICATIONS FOR OSTEOPATH APPLICANTS. Each osteopath applicant shall meet the qualifications prescribed in sec. 200(1), (2), (3) and (6) of this chapter and shall

(1) submit a certificate of graduation from a legally chartered school of osteopathy approved by the board;

(2) submit a certificate from a hospital approved by the American Osteopathic Association which certifies that he has faithfully completed and performed the duties of resident osteopathic physician for one year;

(3) take the examination required by sec. 210 of this chapter. No waiver of this requirement for an osteopath applicant shall be given, the provisions of AS 08.64.250

notwithstanding.

* Sec. 2. The State Medical Board shall grant a license to practice medicine in this state to a person who applies for a license on or before January 1, 1967, if the person has actively engaged in the practice of osteopathy in the state for at least one year before January 1, 1966, and if the person meets all of the requirements in AS 08.64.205 except that the person is not required to take the examination prescribed in AS 08.64.205(3).

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
