HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 16

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting the Governor to direct the Commissioner of the Department of Economic Development to file applications for federal funds.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Public Law 89-136 authorizes the making of federal grants and loans to public bodies to aid in financing the construction of specific public projects; and

WHEREAS the benefits of this Act can best be applied in Alaska by systematic direction from the state level;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Commissioner of the Department of Economic Development to execute and file applications on behalf of numerous communities in Alaska with the Economic Development Administration, United States Department of Commerce, for grants and loans to aid in financing the construction of cold storages, generation and transmission facilities, and slaughter house facilities in those areas with commercial and industrial potential relative to fish resource development, domestic animal production, and other home industry growth; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the Commissioner of the Department of Economic Development, where appropriate, to request a grant of 50 per cent; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct

the Commissioner of the Department of Economic Development to request a supplemental grant of up to 30 per cent where applicable; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to authorize Dr. William M. Dickson, Commissioner of the Department of Economic Development, to furnish information as the Economic Development Administration, United States Department of Commerce, may reasonably request in connection with the application.
