HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 28

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the inclusion of  
courses in reindeer husbandry in  
the curriculum of the Nome  
Vocational School.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS reindeer constitute a valuable resource and provide the base for a vital industry in Western Alaska; and

WHEREAS the industry is retarded by a general lack of technical knowledge about reindeer husbandry by those engaged in the industry; and

WHEREAS the further development of the industry can be accomplished only if more people are trained in the methods of reindeer husbandry; and

WHEREAS the William E. Beltz Vocational School at Nome is ideally suited to provide the necessary training;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the State Department of Education to provide appropriate courses in reindeer husbandry in the curriculum of the William E. Beltz Vocational School at Nome.
