HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the late Essie
R. Dale.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS during the interim between legislative sessions death has taken Mrs. Essie R. Dale of Fairbanks; and

WHEREAS Mrs. Dale served as a member of the House of Representatives of the Nineteenth Territorial Legislature; and

WHEREAS she was an active and effective supporter of the Alaska Statehood effort; and

WHEREAS in the 1949 Legislature Representative Dale introduced legislation for increased old-age benefits, low cost public housing, and a Fairbanks branch of the Pioneers' Home, legislation which evidenced her concern for the welfare of senior citizens; and

WHEREAS Mrs. Dale was for many years an active participant in the local, territorial, and national councils of the Democratic Party; and

WHEREAS she devoted considerable time and effort to the business and social development of the City of Fairbanks;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska expresses its esteem for its late colleague and fellow Alaskan Essie R. Dale and extends to her daughters Mrs. Inez Ferguson of Anchorage and Miss Dorothy Dale of Fairbanks its sincerest condolences and best wishes.
