HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 47

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting the Governor to follow  
and report on federal progress  
in the administration of the  
Pribilof Islands.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the report of the Special Commission of the Governor  
in September 1965 published its report on the Economic and Social  
Conditions on the Pribilof Islands; and

WHEREAS this report included several recommendations for the  
improvement of social and economic conditions on the Pribilof  
Islands which will require implementation by federal agencies,  
particularly the Bureau of Commercial Fisheries of the Department  
of the Interior; and

WHEREAS the Legislature and the people of Alaska have a  
continuing and initial concern with developments to alleviate  
or eliminate certain conditions on the Pribilof Islands;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested  
to maintain contact with the U. S. Department of the Interior on  
its implementaion of the Special Commission's report on the  
Pribilof Islands and to report to the people of Alaska directly  
or through the Alaska Human Rights Commission on any progress and  
plans for alleviating the conditions requiring attention on the  
Pribilof Islands.
