HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 50

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the Department of
Labor General Safety Code.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS legislation has been offered regarding the weight of objects which employed women may be required or permitted to lift; and

WHEREAS the health, safety and welfare of employees is of continuing interest to the Legislature; and

WHEREAS the detailed implementation of employment safety laws are best developed and executed under safety regulations promulgated by the state Department of Labor; and

WHEREAS the existing safety regulations of the Department of Labor should be revised and improved periodically in order, among other purposes, to protect female employees from being required or permitted to lift objects of a weight injurious to their safety, health and welfare;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature respectfully requests the Commissioner of Labor to revise, up-date and improve the Department of Labor General Safety Code.
