SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 11

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the establishment of  
a joint library for the Alaska  
Methodist University and the  
Community College in Anchorage.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Community College in Anchorage has a library of only 22,000 volumes; and

WHEREAS the Alaska Methodist University in Anchorage has a library of only 30,000 volumes; and

WHEREAS a 100,000-volume library is necessary for accreditation and for adequate college educational services; and

WHEREAS a practical plan for the establishment of a joint library facility for Alaska Methodist University and the Anchorage Community College has been proposed; and

WHEREAS there are federal grants and matching funds -- some as high as three dollars for each state dollar -- available for library facilities such as this; and

WHEREAS the plan for a joint library facility has been approved by the President of Alaska Methodist University and the Citizens' Advisory Group for the Anchorage Community College;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska is directed to conduct a study of the feasibility of the establishment of a joint library facility, is directed to seek assistance from Alaska Methodist University in conducting the study, and is directed to report the findings to the Governor and

to send copies of the report to each member of the Legislature by August 1, 1966.

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to Dr. William R. Wood, President of the University of Alaska; the members of the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska; Dr. Fred McGinnis, President of Alaska Methodist University; and the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of the State of Alaska.
