SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 18

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the leasing of
space from the Alaska State
Housing Authority.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the legislature by Chapter 99, Session Laws of Alaska, 1965 provided for the construction and acquisition by the Alaska State Housing Authority of public buildings for lease to the state; and

WHEREAS a leasing program has been entered into under the Act; and

WHEREAS AS 37.05.280 requires that any additional lease executed after January 1, 1966, which provides for a payment in excess of \$12,000 annually be approved by the legislature; and

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the state to enter into the additional leases set out in this resolution;

BE IT RESOLVED that use of the space to be provided by leases of the following premises and leases of said premises from the Alaska State Housing Authority providing for payments in excess of \$12,000 annually is approved.

The state court and office buildings at Sitka, Anchorage and Fairbanks; the highway department headquarters at Douglas; the state police headquarters at Anchorage; employee housing at Angoon; a one-classroom addition at Ambler; a one-classroom addition at Stony River; employee housing at Manley Hot Springs; a new jail facility at Juneau; the Community Building located

at 150 Third Street, Juneau; Fish and Game headquarters building at Cold Bay; Anchorage District Highway complex; Ninilchik Highway Maintenance Shop; and Bernice Lake Highway Maintenance Shop and Employee Housing.
