IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting the Governor to
return Senate Bill No. 198
to the Legislature for a
technical change.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Legislature has sent Senate Bill No. 198, as amended by the House, to the Governor; and

WHEREAS, since the passage of the bill, a technical defect has been discovered which requires that it be returned to the Legislature for remedial action; and

WHEREAS it is the practice to request the Governor to return a bill to the Legislature by the passage of a concurrent resolution approved by a majority of the membership of each house;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to return Senate Bill No. 198, a bill for "An Act to provide public buildings for the use of the state and its political subdivisions", to the Senate for a technical change.
