SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 1

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting electrical generating
equipment for Port Lions and Old
Harbor, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS electric energy is a basic requirement for the
maintenance of homes and the basic services of a community; and

WHEREAS the communities of Port Lions and Old Harbor on
Kodiak Island do not now have the basic light and power needs; and

WHEREAS both communities are in need of electrical generating
facilities to supply their basic domestic needs as well as to
provide the additional electric power to permit them to attract
fish processing plants to give them an adequate economic base;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Rural Electrification Administration
is requested, with the active cooperation of the Kodiak Electric
Association, to take appropriate action to establish electrical
generating facilities at Port Lions and Old Harbor, Alaska, to
provide their basic domestic needs and to allow the communities
to attract fish processing plants to give an adequate base for
their economies.
