SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 3

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting the installation of
a VORTAC navigational aid facility
at Barrow, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS there is now a need for navigational aids for those using the airways between Fairbanks and Barrow, Alaska; and

WHEREAS the only navigational aid facility in the area is a radio facility at Umiat operated by Wien Air Alaska Airlines at its own expense; and

WHEREAS it is recognized by commercial airline and regulatory authorities that a dual VORTAC facility at Barrow is needed if the growing air traffic in the area is to have the necessary air navigational aids;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Federal Aviation Agency is requested to establish a dual VORTAC navigational aid facility at Barrow to serve the air traffic between Fairbanks and Barrow and the surrounding areas at the earliest possible time.

Gary, Director, Alaskan Region, Federal Aviation Agency; and to the Honorable E. L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
