AN ACT

Relating to old age assistance payments; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.25.430(a) is amended to read:

(a) Financial assistance shall be given under secs. 430 - 610 of this chapter, so far as practicable under the conditions of the state, to every aged, needy resident of the state who has attained the age of 65 years, who has not made a voluntary assignment or transfer of property to qualify for assistance, and who has resided in the state for one year immediately preceding the date of application; provided, that if the state in which a person resided immediately before moving to Alaska permits welfare assistance to aged needy Alaskans moving to that state before the expiration of a year or a lesser period of time, that person may qualify as an aged needy resident after residing in Alaska for a period of time equal to the period of residency required by his former state. Assistance shall be in an amount which will provide the applicant with a reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health, but shall in no case exceed \$200 a calendar month. Direct payments for medical services and remedial care shall not be considered in determining the maximum amount payable.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
