AN ACT

Relating to immunization in schools.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.30.065 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.30.065. SUPERVISION. The program of physical examination and immunizations prescribed by secs. 65 - 125 of this chapter shall be under the general supervision and in accordance with regulations of the Department of Health and Welfare.

* Sec. 2. AS 14.30.125 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.30.125. IMMUNIZATION. If in the judgment of the commissioner of health and welfare it is necessary for the welfare of the children or the general public in an area, the governing body of the school district shall require the children attending school in that area to be immunized against the diseases the commissioner of health and welfare may specify.
