AN ACT

Relating to the Advisory Board on Alcoholism.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 44.29.040 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.29.040. COMPOSITION. The advisory board on alcoholism consists of nine members appointed by the governor.

* Sec. 2. AS 44.29.050(c) is amended to read:

(c) One member shall be a person who has evidenced an interest in the problems of alcoholism and who has knowledge of the social problems encountered in the rehabilitation of alcoholics.

* Sec. 3. AS 44.29.050 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

(d) One member shall be a public health nurse.

(e) One member shall be a representative of the liquor industry.

(f) One member shall be a member of Alcoholics Anonymous.

(g) One member shall be from the public at large.

(h) One member shall be a social worker.

* Sec. 4. AS 44.29.060(d) is amended to read:

(d) The members initially appointed under sec. 50(c) - (h) of this chapter serve a term of four years. Subsequent terms for all board members are for four years.

- * Sec. 5. AS 44.29.070 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.29.070. COMPENSATION, PER DIEM, OR EXPENSES. Members of the advisory board on alcoholism are not entitled to a salary, but are entitled to per diem, reimbursement for travel and other expenses authorized by law for other boards.

- * Sec. 6. Sec. 44.29 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 44.29.090. ALCOHOLISM PROGRAM COORDINATOR. The alcoholism program coordinator shall carry out the development and implementation of a comprehensive program dealing with the treatment, research, and education of alcoholic problems as they affect the state. The coordinator is appointed by the governor with the approval of the board.
